Many thanks for your letter of May 25.

As you know, the Board has been studying coeducation since October 1983, and we put in three full days on the matter last weekend. You will be interested to know that during the course of those meetings I declared myself in favor of coeducation for many of the same reasons you mentioned in your letter.

The Board of Trustees will meet again on the issue during the middle of July, and I expect that we will take our formal vote at that time. At the present time I would say that the Board is about evenly split, but we will do whatever is necessary to reach a concensus one way or the other.
